Year 6 SAT's Breakfast:

Dear Parents/Carers

As you are aware, SATs Week is the week beginning 13th May. Children need to be in school Monday 13th May through to Thursday 16th May at **8.15am**. (If your child is at before school club, they will come to the hall at this time.)

We will be providing them with an **extra breakfast** before they start the tests. This is a time to chat and relax with friends before the rest of the school arrive. Children can have breakfast at home or in school or both depending on their preference.

During the SATs tests, with the <u>exception</u> of the Reading test, children are allowed to ask an adult to read questions to them. There will be adults in the room available for this purpose. The children are used to this practice and we strongly encourage them to do so as this often helps them to understand the questions better. There is no limit to how many questions they can ask to be read to them. This is in line with the guidance issued by the Standards and Testing Agency.
