

Measure: length and height (centimetres and metres)

<p>Go outside and collect lots of sticks and leaves – can you put them in order from the shortest to longest?</p>	<p>Make a list of things that you would measure in centimetres and things that you would measure in metres.</p>	<p>Practise using a ruler to measure in cms – you could measure your toys, some books, pens and pencils etc.</p>
<p>Can you draw a line that is 1cm long? Now 30cm? how many accurate lines can you draw of the numbers in-between?</p>	<p>Measure the length of 10 items. How many different ways can you add or subtract those lengths?</p>	<p>Find an item in your house/garden/on a walk – find 5 things shorter and 5 things longer/taller than it. Can you make a table to show your findings?</p>
<p>Collect some items from around the house/garden. Can you estimate how long they are? Now measure them. Were you close?</p>	<p>Measure the feet of everyone in your house in cms. Who has the shortest? Longest? What is the difference?</p>	<p>Measure the length of one thing and then use that to estimate the length of others. E.g. the pencil case is 20cm and the pen is a little bit shorter so I think it is 16cm.</p>
