<p>Maths (Shape)</p>	<p>Go on a 3D shape hunt around your house. You can write down what you have found, take pictures of them or draw them.</p> <p><i>Can you find cubes, cylinders, cuboids, pyramids, cones and spheres?</i></p>	<p>What is the difference between a 2D and 3D shape? Can you see any 2D shapes on the 3D shapes that you have found?</p> <p>Have a look at a cube – how many square faces are there? Now look at the other shapes – what 2D shapes do you notice?</p>	<p>Can you describe the 3D shapes that you have found using the vocabulary edges, vertices and faces?</p> <p>e.g. a cylinder has 2 edges, 0 vertices and 3 faces (one curved and 2 flat)</p>	<p>How many 2D shapes can you name and describe?</p> <p><i>Can you draw the shapes? Can you label with how many sides and corners (vertices) they have?</i></p>	<p>Can you find some objects that have a vertical line of symmetry?</p>

Be as creative as you can.</p> <p><i>You could use Lego, sticks, cardboard, paper etc.</i></p>	<p>If you were an animal, what would you be? Draw you as that animal.</p> <p><i>Think about your personality, which animal matches that?</i></p>
