First, think of the main events that happened. You can write them down or draw pictures of them so that you have them look at when you are retelling the story.

Now, make sure that they are in the correct order – it's very important that this is done correctly so that it will make sense when you are retelling the story.

Practise retelling the story using interesting words/phrases to begin your sentences, e.g. *the next morning, it was about that time, then, next, after that, suddenly, finally.*

You could video record yourself telling the story, tell it to a family member over the phone, write it down, make models and have them act it out etc. Be creative and have fun ⁽¹⁾
