Please have a go at drawing some of these shapes and writing their properties next to them.



Any shape with 3 sides and 3 corners (vertices) is a triangle.






Any shape with 5 sides and 5 corners (vertices) is a pentagon.

Hexagons




If a shape is in a different orientation, is doesn't change which shape it is.


