

Maths Ideas

<p>Write the numbers 0-20 in words and digits</p>	<p>Find objects around the house. Can you order them from lightest to heaviest? Which items weigh the same?</p>	<p>Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. (You could use pairs of socks, gloves or the hands of people in your house – draw around their hands to help you count in 5s and 10s/ draw around their feet to help you count in 2s)</p>	<p>Make a 100 square. Can you spot any patterns? Make a part-whole model and show how many tens and ones are in a number you choose</p>
<p>Go on a shape hunt. How many 2d and 3d shapes can you find? Can you name them?</p>	<p>Look out of your window. How many cars go past? What is the most popular colour? What is the least popular colour?</p>	<p>Write as many number sentences as you can using the numbers 3, 7 and 10, eg; <math>7+3=10</math>, <math>10-3=7</math> (Ask an adult to give you different numbers)</p>	<p>Roll 2 dice and add the numbers together.</p>
<p>Play a game of snakes and ladders</p>	<p>Use a ruler and measure a variety of objects in the home. Can you record their measurement in cm? Which is the shortest? Which is the longest?</p>	<p>Look outside, how many flowers/creatures can you count?</p>	<p>Practise telling the time to an hour and half past the hour. What time is dinner, bedtime etc.</p>
<p>Can you name the months in order? What celebrations happen each month? Find out when the birthdays of your family members are.</p>	<p>Practise number bonds to 10/20.</p>	<p>Count on from a two-digit number. Now can you count backwards.</p>	<p>Add and subtract numbers</p>

Phonics / English

<p>How many times can you write a tricky word in 1 minute (see attached sheet)</p>	<p>Play a phonics game on <a href="#">Top Marks</a> or <a href="#">ICT Games</a></p>	<p>Spell the days of the week. Have you noticed any patterns? Can you remember your capital letters?</p>	<p>Create a booklet about your family. Why are they special to you? Can you name all of the people in your family?</p>
<p>Design your own alien. Can you make up a name for your alien and add sound buttons and dashes? (charb) — — •</p>	<p>Practise reading and spelling tricky words and high frequency words. (see attached). Can you write them in your blue books?</p>	<p>Read your reading book and change the main character or the story ending by writing your own story. Read it at bedtime to a family member.</p>	<p>Read a traditional story – The Gingerbread Man/Three Billy Goats Gruff/Little Red Riding Hood/Three Little Pigs etc.</p>
<p>Practise your cursive handwriting (see attached sheet). Write the alphabet!</p>	<p>Practise writing your first and second name.</p>	<p>Write a letter to a friend.</p>	<p><a href="#">Use Pobble 365</a> to write a sentence about one of the pictures.</p>

Theme Work (Science, Geography...)

<p>A-Z Animal list. Can you think of an animal for each letter of the alphabet? Can you add dots and dashes?</p>	<p>Discuss the materials in your house. Can you find anything made from metal / glass / plastic / fabric / wood?</p>	<p>What can you see outside of your window? What does your house look like from the outside? Can you draw your house?</p>	<p>Keep a diary of what you do each day, or what the weather is like each day! Can you spot a pattern?</p>
<p>Support your child to find out their address. Can they find the number on the door?</p>	<p>Research the meaning of Easter. Record what you find out in your blue books.</p>	<p>Watch the weather report on TV! Can you write a weather report?</p>	<p>Make a timeline of your family. Who is the youngest? Who is the oldest? Are there any special events to be added to your timeline?</p>
