Breakfast Club

Our Breakfast Club is run by school staff and available Monday to Friday from 7:45am- 8:45am at a cost of £4.00 per day. This cost includes breakfast. A mini breakfast club is also available from 8:15am - 8:45am at a cost of £2.00 per day.

A booking form needs to be filled out and payment made in advance. Booking forms are available from the school office. Payments must be made by ParentPay.

After School Club - Whizz Kids

Whizz Kids is our After-School Club, which operates between 3:15pm until 6pm. The cost of this is £8.00 per session. Child care vouchers may be used in full or as part payment for this facility. A light meal is also provided and included in the cost.

A separate registration/booking form needs to be completed and are available from School office. Payments must be made by ParentPay.

Absence & Illness

The school promotes a positive approach to punctual attendance - we have weekly rewards and attendance graphs are shown every Friday in assembly

If your child is absent, you <u>MUST</u> telephone or <u>Email</u> the school to inform us of the reason why they are absence before <u>9.30am</u>.

If we have not heard by this time we will telephone home and it maybe that a home visit will be undertaken.

Unauthorised absence - A register will be marked authorised if a child arrives late (after registration closes - 9:05am) or if the school does not receive a satisfactory reason for a child being absent. It is the Headteachers decision on whether an absence is authorised.

Any medical/dental appointments your child has you we will need provide proof of the appointment to the school before the appointment.

If your child becomes ill at school we will inform you immediately. Therefore, we do ask you to let us have your telephone number and the number of a relative, friend or neighbour, so that we may contact you in emergencies. This is normally supplied on the contact form but from time to time details alter so we ask if you can try to keep our information up to date, especially with mobile phone numbers.

If your child has been vomiting or had diarrhoea, they need to be kept off school for 48 hours AFTER the last sickness or diarrhoea episode.



Medicine can be given in school if it has been prescribed by a doctor and has to be administered 4 times a day. Parents must bring the medication to the office so that there can be no misunderstanding. It must be marked with the child's name and dosage. A consent form will need to be completed. Medicines are overseen by an adult and entered in the school medical record book.

Leave of Absence

We follow the Peterborough City Council Policy: Promoting Good School Attendance.

'Taking leave of absence without exceptional circumstances in term time will affect your child's schooling as much as any other absence and we expect parents to help us by not taking children away in school time. Remember that any savings you may make by taking a holiday in school times are offset by the cost of your child's education.

There is NO automatic entitlement in law to time off in school time, to go on holiday.

All applications for leave of absence must be made in advance. In making a decision about whether to authorise this leave, the school will consider the circumstances of each application individually, including any previous pattern of absence.

It is important that you understand that we will ONLY authorise such absence in EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES.

Any period of leave taken without the agreement of the school (with at least four week's notice) and /or different from that agreed by the school, will be classed as unauthorised and may attract sanctions such as an penalty notice.

Newsletter

School's newsletter is sent home weekly every Thursday. This will be sent as an email to all parents. A paper copy can be sent on request.

Letters will be send home either via email or paper copy as appropriate. Copies of letters will be also available on our website.

School Meals and Packed Lunches

Dinners are cooked on the premises and the daily menu offers a choice of two hot dishes or a salad for main course and a range of puddings.

Children may bring packed lunches. They must be in a named container or holder; no fizzy drinks or nuts please. We can provide guidance on how to provide a health packed lunch - leaflets are available in school.

We do NOT buy in ready made meals (e.g. Cottage Pie, Lasagne and Spaghetti Bolognese). All our meals are made by our wonderful cooks from scratch, using locally sourced ingredients and meat.

Milk is available for <u>all</u> pupils as a drink during school lunch.

Weekly School Menu

Universal Free School Meals

From September 2014 all Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children are entitled to a universal free school meal.

Dinner Money - Key Stage 2 only (Years 3,4,5& 6)

The cost of lunch for Key Stage 2 pupil is £2.50 per day. Payments are to be made by ParentPay. If your child's dinner money account has a debt of more than £12, we will not be giving any more hot meals unless this is paid off. In these circumstances we will only give Cheese and biscuits and water for lunch as we will make sure that no child is hungry but we do not operate a credit system.



Some children are entitled to free school meals. The school can help to advise you on how to apply for them. Each case is dealt with in the strictest confidence. Forms are available in school and should be returned to, along with the required information to the school office where they can be processed.

School Uniform

We actively encourage school uniform as we believe that this helps the children to take pride in their appearance and it helps develop a positive attitude to each school day.

The school colour is bottle green. All children should have sensible black shoes and extreme hairstyles and colours are discouraged.
